

## AYLESBURY BREWHOUSE OPENING & FESTIVAL

We are all ready now for the Aylesbury Brewhouse Opening and Festival. We would love you to be there to share the launch with us, as we open the first new brewery in Aylesbury for nearly 75 years.

### Two new Aylesbury Brewhouse beers will be available:

**Alpha** - Our first Aylesbury beer and our first use of the tettnang hop. A 3.8% a pale and hoppy beer.

**Red Right Hand** - Amber and chocolate malts create a 4.2% light chestnut colour with Green Bullet and Northdown hops adding a strong bitter finish.
