

## BEER FESTIVAL TASTING NOTES FOR THE FOX MIDDLE BARTON

1. **Tring – Brookman’s (4.1%)**  
Bitter-sweet, deep red coloured ale with a complex aromatic hoppy finish. Well balanced.
2. **Tring – Side Pocket for a Toad (3.6%)**  
Unmistakable citrus notes from only the best Cascade hops balanced with a floral aroma and crisp dry finish make this straw coloured ale a fantastic session beer.
3. **Tring – Ridgeway Bitter (4.0%)**  
A beer with a pleasant mix of hop and malt flavours in the aroma and taste, leading to a dry, often flowery hop, aftertaste.
4. **Buntingford – Hurricane Force (4.3%)**  
Light copper/brown best bitter brewed with Fuggle hops for a traditional best bitter taste & feel
5. **Potbelly – Beijing Black (4.4%)**  
A strong dark mild, Mild but not Meek!!
6. **Hopping Mad – Fruit Case (4.5%)**  
An intricate, well balanced, drinkable and delicious Gold Ale Well balanced and interesting flavours using a delicate combination of highly appealing hops, the perfect accompaniment to a range of subtle flavours driven by a blend of malts.
7. **York – Guzzler (3.6%)**  
A light golden beer with well balanced hops and malt against a background of fruitiness. Crisp, dry, and refreshing, Guzzler is a perfect beer for drinking all year round
8. **Concrete Cow – Cloven Hoof (4.5%)**  
A ruby black stout given its name because we think it's "devilishly" good. Brewed with plenty of roasted barley and dark malts and natural vanilla pods for a traditional stout flavour and a sweeter twist. Great chilled as a summer thirst quencher.
9. **North Yorkshire – Hit and Run (4.5%)**  
A blonde beer brewed with raspberries.
10. **Oakham – Green Devil IPA (6.0%)**  
Smooth and fruity to start with passion fruit, pineapple and mango developing into lemon and lime. A citrusy bitterness complements a crisp and dry aftertaste.
11. **Frog Island – Best Bitter (3.8%)**  
Brewed in the typical style of a 'Best Bitter' to produce a well-rounded malty body with a slight fruitiness. The bitterness of the hops develops into a bitter, astringent aftertaste.

**12. White Horse – Village Idiot (4.1%)**

Blonde straw coloured ale with a Complex hop aroma. A light fruity ale with citrus notes and a dry finish.

**13. Hook Norton – Gold (4.1%)**

Pale crisp beer with a fruity aroma and pleasant light taste, the first Hook Norton beer to use American hops.
